The Board of Trustees approved the following agenda items:

Educational Section

- TEA: COVID-19 School Health Support Grant in the amount of \$1,951,642
- Agreement with ProComputing to uninstall and dispose of 2,160 Generation 1 and 2 Promethean ActivBoards and to install 2,160 new Promethean ActivBoards using Certified Promethean Board Installation for the amount of \$3,002,400
- Revised Prekindergarten Tuition Rates, effective beginning with the 2022-2023 school year
- Authorization of Allen Brown and Donna Summers to act as the superintendent primary request approver designees for approving staff requests (also referred to as “submitting requests to TEA”) for access to one or more TEA web applications accessed through the Texas Education Agency Login System (TEAL). This authorization is valid for the calendar year starting May 1, 2022, to April 30, 2023
- Interlocal Agreement with Harris County to provide free at home COVID-19 rapid antigen tests to targeted student populations
- Resolution to the Texas Association of School Boards for the Nomination of Dr. DeeAnn Powell as Superintendent of the Year
- Career and Technical Education students to participate in national competitions during the spring and summer of 2022, for the cost of approximately \$40,000
- Sam Rayburn High School Texan Battalion Army JROTC Leadership team to travel to Washington D.C. June 19 – June 23, 2022, to compete in the Joint Leadership and Academic Bowl (JLAB) Championships
- Pasadena Memorial High School to travel to Bloomington, IL on June 19-25, 2022, to attend the National Thespian Competition and Festival at a cost of \$16,000
- J. Frank Dobie High School Speech/Debate qualifying team members to travel to three national championship events: NCFL (Grand National Tournament), and NSDA (National Speech and Debate Association Championship) not to exceed \$35,000
- J. Frank Dobie High School JROTC team members to travel to The Nationals - A National High School Drill Competition in Daytona Beach, Florida on April 14-17,

2022, not to exceed \$6,000
